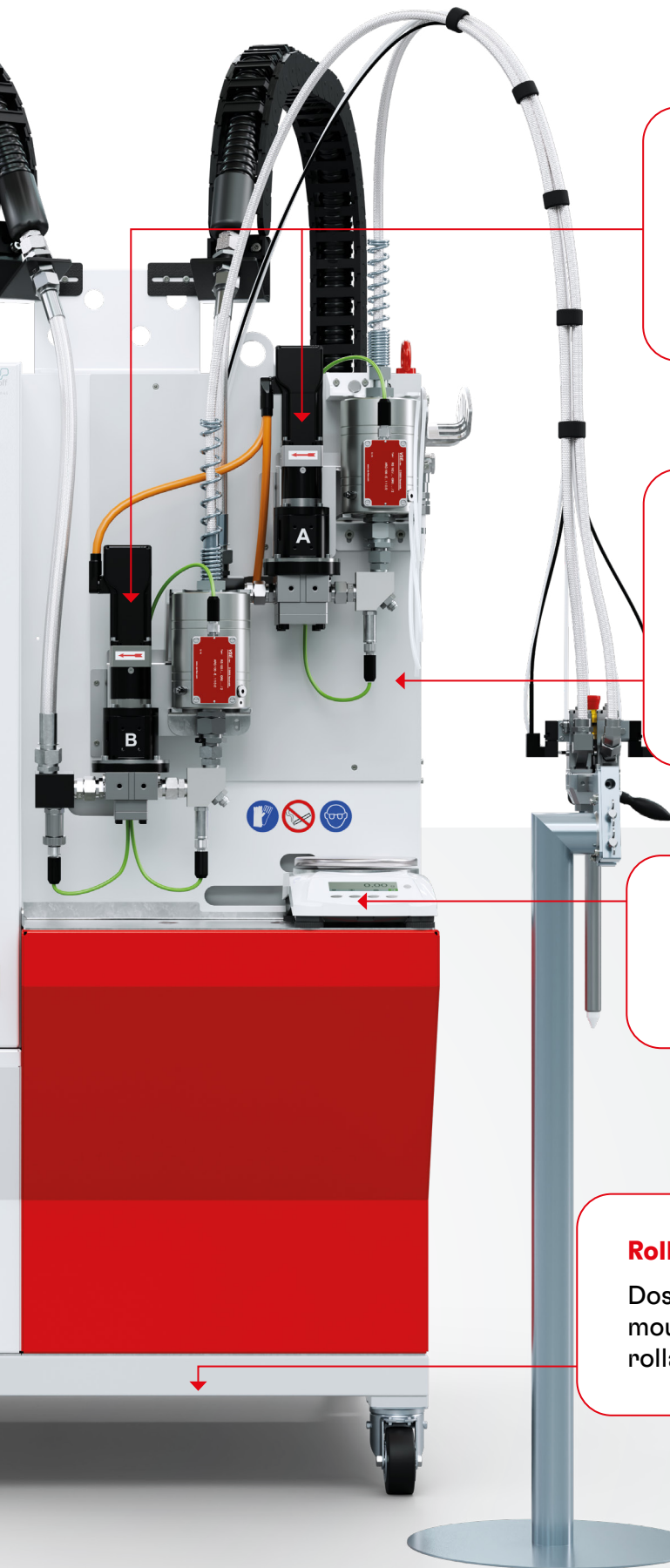

Both gear pumps and screw pumps are available for particularly abrasive materials. The pump size is individually adapted to the customer's process.

2K precision mixing head with dynamic or static mixing

with servo drives, for discharge rates infinitely variable from 0,2 to 30 g/s and mixing ratios from 10:1 to 1 : 1 (depending on pump size and material viscosity)
